

Features of Current Program Finder


Allows the user to filter programs by: Keyword, Date range, Topic, Location, Eligibility (GMP & AFP), Type (Partnerships, Industry Association), and Duration (1-3 Days, 4-7 Days, Multi-Week)

Results show: Total # of Programs, Title,
Description, Date, Topic, Location, Cost, and
Audience, Alumni Status



Findings

- Number of programs listed ranged between 24 (Chicago) and 68 (Wharton) programs. With an average of 50.6 programs
- All allowed to filter by topic and date range
- Harvard and INSEAD grouped dates into one program listing instead of a separate listing for each date
- Columbia and Stanford included online programs





Comparison Tool

Our users review several programs before deciding on their chosen program. A comparison tool would improve their browsing experience.

- Both <u>Harvard</u> and <u>Stanford</u> allow users to compare up to 3 programs (summary, benefits, logistics, audience, and what is awarded upon completion).
- After comparing, users can contact the School, download PDFs, or apply.
- Stanford allows the comparison to be downloaded into a PDF



Additional Ideas

FILTER BY COMPETENCY

Each program could have 3-5 competencies assigned to it. These could be listed on the program page and filtered by the program finder

ADDITION OF CTA BUTTONS

Chicago, Columbia, and INSEAD include apply buttons.

Kellogg, Stanford, Harvard, and INSEAD provide the ability to save programs and download a brochure

STREAMLINE RESULTS LISTS

Limit what is displayed to what is of key interest to the user and put the rest behind the toggle
